This form must be completed and returned with the cost of the trip to the teacher sponsoring the trip six days prior to the date of the trip for the student to be eligible to participate. Exceptions to this rule will only be made by the assistant principle in extenuating circumstances.

Points to consider in planning to participate on a field trip:

1. Completed permission slips signed by parents or guardians must be received six days prior to the trip.
2. Students going on the trip are responsible for all transportation expenses and fees.
3. Students are responsible for notifying their teachers in advanced of the trip and for making up all work missed because of field trips. If a student fails to make up work, s/he will be given a failing grade for that work. A student is expected to take a test missed because of a field trip the day after the field trip. A student must submit his/her schoolwork (homework, papers, projects) that is due on the day of the field trip before s/he leaves on the field trip.
4. Any student who violates the schools' alcohol and drug policy included in section D of the Student Handbook or any other Handbook rule may be sent home via public transportation or taxi at his/her parents' expense.

Students are advised that missing school for extended trips can have an adverse impact on academic achievement in some courses. Class teachers are not responsible for tutoring a student who has missed school because of a school sanctioned field trip.
